Monday	<p>Child to read to an adult for 20 mins daily. Read for pleasure – share a story -20 mins.</p> <p>Find 3 objects in your house or garden that begin with the sound 'S'. Make a list with your mum and dad. Draw a picture of each object.</p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname</p> <p>Write the letter: <i>S</i></p> <p><i>Whoosh in and curl left. Curl right then lead out of your s.</i></p>	<p>Go and find 10 blue objects.</p> <p>Count them to make sure you have 10.</p>
Tuesday	<p>Read for pleasure – share a story - 20 mins at least daily</p> <p>Read the tricky words</p> <p><i>I no go to the into</i></p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname</p> <p>Write the letter <i>a</i></p> <p><i>Whoosh in and round you go. Up, down and kick out a's toe.</i></p>	<p>Practice forming number 1 in a tray of flour/sand</p> <p>Draw or paint a rainbow (See Tuesday Draw a Rainbow handout)</p>
Wednesday	<p>Read for pleasure – share a story - 20 mins at least daily</p> <p>Ask questions about your stories Who is the character? What happens in the story? Retell in order.</p> <p>Find 3 objects in your house or garden that begin with the letter <i>A</i>. Make a list with your mum and dad. Draw a picture of each object.</p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname</p> <p>Write the letter <i>t</i></p> <p><i>Whoosh to the top and back down, Then add a flick off of the ground. You need to cross the t. With a straight line on his tummy</i></p>	<p>Make a fruit salad and cut them into different shapes.</p> <p>Then enjoy eating your fruit salad.</p>
Thursday	<p>Read for pleasure – share a story - 20 mins at least daily</p> <p>Draw a picture of your favourite character and tell you parents why you chose them.</p> <p>I like my character because...</p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname</p> <p>Practice writing the words</p> <p><i>sat at</i> <i>as</i></p> <p><i>Remember your cursive writing.</i></p>	<p>Go into the garden and count the petals on flowers and leaves on plants.</p>

Friday	<p>Read for pleasure – share a story - 20 mins at least daily</p> <p>Play the 'pairs game' with your tricky words. Who can find the most pairs of tricky words?</p> <p>Complete my Five Senses Scavenger Hunt (See Friday Five Senses Scavenger Hunt handout)</p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname</p> <p>Write the letter <i>p</i></p> <p><i>Whoosh in and then go down low. Back up to top and round you go. Lead out at the end, So that p can join onto a friend.</i></p>	<p>Walk around your house and see how many different shapes you can find.</p> <p>Can you find a square, triangle, circle or rectangle?</p>
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
