Wednesday	<p>Read for pleasure – share a story - 20 mins at least daily</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask questions about your stories • Who is the character? • What happens in the story? • Retell in order. <p>Find 3 objects in your house or garden that begin with the letter 'n'. Make a list with your mum and dad. Draw a picture of each object. Practice making the sound.</p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname</p> <p>Write the letter <i>c</i> <i>Whoosh in and curl the c. C joins other letters easily.</i></p>	<p>Collect different items from around the house or garden. Match them to the collect number.</p> <p><i>(See Wednesday Backyard number boxes handout.)</i></p>
Thursday	<p>Read for pleasure – share a story - 20 mins at least daily</p> <p>Talk about a good or bad character from your story. What makes the character good or bad? Draw your favourite evil character. Can you describe what he or she looks like?</p> <p>I like this character because...</p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname Practice writing the words</p> <p><i>pin</i> <i>sock</i> <i>tap</i> <i>got</i> <i>cat</i> <i>dog</i></p> <p><i>Remember your cursive writing.</i></p>	<p>Make a shape picture using different shapes. Can you use a square, triangle, rectangle or circle?</p> <p>Tell your mum and dad the shapes you have used. Can you describe the shape?</p> <p><i>(See Thursday Shape Picture handout)</i></p>
Friday	<p>Read for pleasure – share a story - 20 mins at least daily.</p> <p><i>(Friday- I spy with my little eye –toys see picture handout.)</i> Can you hear the beginning sound?</p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname</p> <p>Write the letter <i>k</i>. <i>Whoosh up tall and back down. Go halfway up and around. Go down and out with a flick.</i> <i>Your k is ready to kick!</i></p>	<p>Draw a creature/alien. It must have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 3 heads 5 legs 4 eyes 2 arms 1 nose <p>Make sure you have drawn the correct amount. Draw another one and show your family. <i>(See Friday Draw an alien handout.)</i></p>
