Monday	<p>Child to read to an adult for 20 mins daily. Read for pleasure – share a story (for example <i>The Gruffalo</i>, <i>Goldilocks and the three bears</i>- we have learnt these in class they should be good at answering questions about them)</p> <p>Watch Mr Thorne does phonics – oo (long)</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=eAkepSft6S0</p> <p>Can we read the words too/boom/root in 1 minute</p>	<p>Name writing- First and surname</p> <p>Write the letter:  Discuss its sound and letter name</p> <p>Whoosh in, go around to the top. Go down under the line loop and stop.</p>	<p>We need to learn how to take a double numbers.</p> <p>Remind children of + and = Say to the children to collect 2 objects, and put them to one side, then ask the children to do the same again. Make sure the numbers are the same on both sides.</p> <p>Can you double 1, using objects? Can you double 2, using objects? Can you double 3, using objects?</p>
Tuesday	<p>Child to read to an adult for 20 mins daily. Read for pleasure – share a story.</p> <p>Complete Reading of moon/spoon/zoom in 1 minute.</p> <p>Read: The man is on the moon. Ask: Where is the man?</p>	 <p><i>Can you write a sentence about this picture?</i> <i>Can you use the long oo sound?</i></p>	<p>Remind the children what + means and = means</p> <p>Use sweets/toys etc to work out the answers? Double 4 Double 5 Double 6</p> <p>Can you write the answers?</p> <p>Make sure numbers are formed the correct way around.</p>
Wednesday	<p>Child to read to an adult for 20 mins daily. Read for pleasure – share a story. (for example <i>The Three Billy Goats Gruff</i>, <i>Jack and the beanstalk</i>- we have learnt these in class they should be good at answering questions about them)</p> <p>Tricky word hunt Write tricky words on pieces of paper/post its and hide them around the room. Can you find them and read them:</p> <p>We, me, be, she, he, me was, they, all, are, you, her, my</p>	<p>Name writing- First and surname</p> <p>Write the letter:  Discuss its sound and letter name</p> <p>Whoosh in and up tall and then down, Halfway up, bend over and flick off the ground.</p>	<p>Write numbers on pieces of paper, 1-10, then 20</p> <p>Can you put them in the correct order? Can you write them?</p> <p>Make sure numbers are formed the correct way around.</p>

<p>Thursday</p>	<p>Child to read to an adult for 20 mins daily.</p> <p>Read for pleasure – share a story – 20 mins.</p> <p>Watch Mr Thorne does phonics with Geraldine Giraffe – oo (short)</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=vR47jG-imRo</p> <p>Can we read the words foot, good, wool in 1 minute</p>	 <p><i>Can you write a sentence about this picture? Can you use the short oo sound?</i></p>	<p>Remind the children what + means and = means</p> <p>Look at the calculations:</p> <p>2+2= 3+3= 4+4= 5+5=</p> <p>Use dots/circles on paper, can you work out the answers?</p> <p>Can they write the answer on a piece of paper?</p>
<p>Friday</p>	<p>Child to read to an adult for 20 mins daily.</p> <p>Read for pleasure – share a story - 20 mins.</p> <p>Remind Children of the sounds oo and how there is a long oo (moon) and a short oo (wood).</p> <p>Can you write down as many words with the new sounds in them?</p> <p>Can you spell tricky words: he, she, me ,we ,be, me</p>	<p>Name writing- First and surname</p> <p>Where is your favourite place to go? Can you write about? Example. I like to go to the park.</p>	<p>Complete the ladybird sheet attached.</p> <p>If you cannot print, can you draw the ladybirds with the correct spots and write calculations?</p>
