## What is Easter?

Easter is an important Christian festival.

<b>Easter Bunny</b>	Legend says that the Easter Bunny lays, decorates and hides new eggs.
<b>Easter bonnet</b>	The Easter bonnet tradition follows on from people wearing new clothes at Easter time to represent new life.
<b>Hot cross buns</b>	At Easter time, hot cross buns are baked and eaten. The cross reminds people of Jesus.
