Monday	<p>Child to read to an adult for 20 mins daily. Read for pleasure – share a story -20 mins.</p> <p>Find 3 objects in your house or garden that begin with the sound 'k'. Make a list with your mum and dad. Draw a picture of each object.</p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname</p> <p>Write the letter: <b>S</b> Whoosh in and curl left. Curl right then lead out of your s.</p>	<p>Go and find 10 red objects.</p> <p>Count them to make sure you have 10</p>

Up, down and kick out a's toe.</p>	<p>Practice forming number 2 in a tray of flour/sand</p> <p>Draw a picture of a mini beast that you found in your garden and put it in the window.</p> <p>(See Tuesday Mini Beast Picture)</p>
Wednesday	<p>Read for pleasure – share a story - 20 mins at least daily</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ask questions about your stories</li> <li>• Who is the character?</li> <li>• What happens in the story?</li> <li>• Retell in order.</li> </ul> <p>Find 3 objects in your house or garden that begin with the letter 'e'. Make a list with your mum and dad. Draw a picture of each object. Practice making the sound.</p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname</p> <p>Write the letter <b>t</b> Whoosh to the top and back down, Then add a flick off of the ground. You need to cross the t. With a straight line on his tummy</p>	<p>Play Mini Beast I –Spy and Count</p> <p>(See Wednesday Mini Beast I-Spy and Count.)</p>
Thursday	<p>Read for pleasure – share a story - 20 mins at least daily</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ask questions about your stories</li> <li>• Who is the character?</li> <li>• What happens in the story?</li> <li>• Retell in order.</li> </ul> <p>Find 3 objects in your house or garden that begin with the letter 'u'. Make a list with your mum and dad. Draw a picture of each object. Practice making the sound.</p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname</p> <p>Practice writing the words hat bed mat lip</p> <p>Remember your cursive writing.</p>	<p>Make a fruit kebab. Can you make a pattern? (See Thursday Fruit Kebab)</p> <p>Email your picture to Mrs Decicco. I would love to see them.</p>
Friday	<p>Read for pleasure – share a story - 20 mins at least daily.</p> <p>Write a caption/sentence to match the picture. (See Friday Caption Writing handout.)</p>	<p>Name writing- First and then surname</p> <p>Write the letter <b>p</b> Whoosh in and then go down low. Back up to top and round you go. Lead out at the end, So that p can join onto a friend.</p>	<p>Maths Counting to 10 together. Ask your mum to read the different activities and practice counting to 10.</p> <p>(See Friday Counting to 10 activity sheet)</p>
