



(for example <i>The Three Billy goats gruff</i> and <i>The three little pigs</i>)</p> <p>Go on a tricky word hunt</p> <p>We, me, be, she, he, me was, they, all, are, you, her, my</p>	<p>Name writing- First and surname</p> <p>Write the letter: r</p> <p>Discuss its sound and letter name Whoosh to the top to start. Go down and curve the top for your r.</p>	<p>Can you use your 10s frame to show different ways of making 10? Example:</p>
