There are two chairs so two children can sit at each desk. I can count in twos.



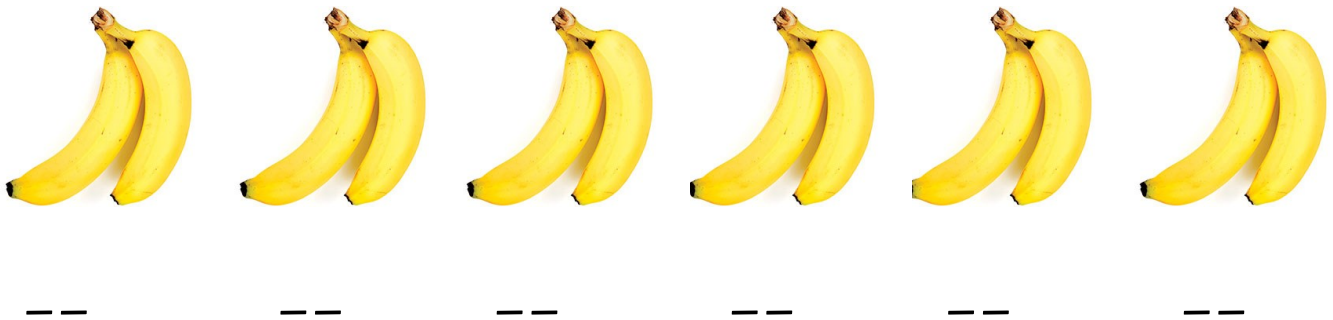
6 children can sit at these tables.
