I How many muffins are there altogether?



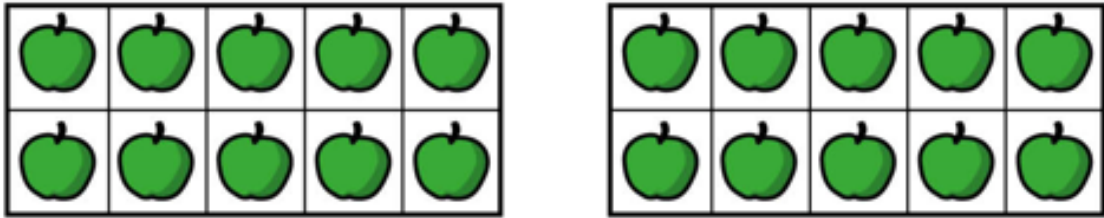

2 How many apples are there altogether?

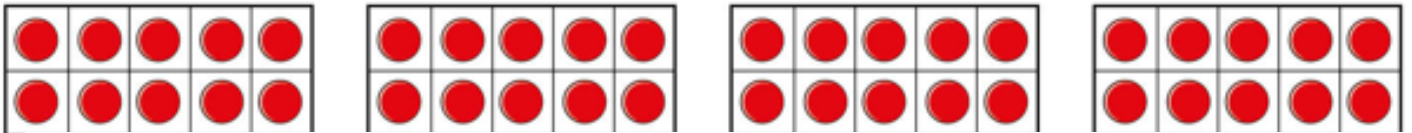


There are apples on each ten frame.
