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## NSPCC NUMBER DAY 2022

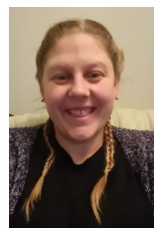
We are taking part in the NSPCC (National Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children) Number Day 2022 on

### COVID School Guidance

**Thank you to all parents for working with us to lateral flow the children and identify and control the cases that we have experienced in school since returning in January.**

Please still continue to lateral flow your child at regular points in the morning before coming to school. If your child tests positive, keep them home for 5 days, test again on day 5 and then on day 6, if both are negative they can return to school on day 6.

If your child has the following symptoms:

⇒ Cough, High temperature, Loss of taste/smell

Please book them in for a PCR test, as relying on just the lateral flow test may not show you accurate results.

*(If your child is identified as a contact of a positive case then we will ask you to lateral flow for 7 days)*

**Where not exempt, we ask you to please wear a mask when dropping and collecting your child due to having cases in school.**

**Thank you for working with the school to keep children and staff safe.**
