COVID School Guidance

Thank you to all parents for working with us to lateral flow the children and identify and control the cases that we have experienced in school since returning in January.

If your child feels unwell please continue to lateral flow in the morning before coming to school. If your child tests positive, keep them home for 5 days, test again on day 5 and then on day 6, if both are negative they can return to school on day 6.

If your child has the following symptoms:

⇒ Cough, High temperature, Loss of taste/smell

Please book them in for a PCR test, as relying on just the lateral flow test may not show you accurate results.
