



HOMEWORK POLICY

PURPOSE

Homework will be used to reinforce and extend the curriculum and to give parents the opportunity to work with and help their child.

DEFINITION

This is work undertaken at home with the support of a parent or other caring adult.

AIM

To give the child opportunities to continue to practise newly acquired skills and inform parents of curriculum coverage.

MONITORING

Nursery – Class Dojo will be used as an online platform for any activities for children to complete at home.

Reception – Reading diaries are sent home weekly and parents are asked to sign this with a comment 3 times a week. Class Dojo will be used as an online platform for homework.

KS1 – Reading diaries are sent home weekly and parents are asked to sign this with a comment 3 times a week. Class Dojo will be used as an online platform for homework and weekly spellings. Portfolio tasks will be set and monitored by the class teacher.

PLANNING

Homework will be planned to support the curriculum in school.

SPELLING

Spellings are sent weekly in KS1 from Anima Phonics and a weekly spelling test will take place of 5 words. These words will be from the phonics or spelling focus that week alongside new rainbow words which have been introduced that week.

CROSS-CURRICULUM

Homework can cover every subject on the curriculum when appropriate. Half termly projects may also be set to support the wider curriculum.
