# Spring 1 Curriculum Map



# English

We will be reading The Gingerbread Man. The children will write a short retell of the familiar traditional tale. We will continue to work on sentence structure - capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. The children will learn about conjunction 'and'. Then begin to use it to join two sentences together.

Key words: conjunction

#### **PSHE**

The children will be learning about Dreams and Goals following the Jigsaw scheme of work.

Key word: achievement

## Computing

The children will be learning about programming and the children will learn how to move a robot.

Key word: algorithm

#### Maths

The children will continue working on place value to 20. Then we will use our knowledge of these numbers and begin to add and subtract within 20. The children will then explore the inverse before moving on to place value to 50. In snappy maths, we will look at the relationship between number bonds to 10 and 20.

Key words: inverse

#### Art

The children will explore how to use paper to create a sculpture.

Key word: sculpture

#### RE

The children will continue learning about Judaism where they will answer the question - Who is Jewish and how do they live?

Key word: mezuzah

#### Science

The children will be learning all about animals including humans. We will be learning about the five animal groups We will also revisit our seasonal change topic and explore what it is like in Winter.

Key words: amphibians, mammals and reptiles

## Geography

The children will be learning about Stoke on Trent. We will look at the towns that make up Stoke on Trent. Within this unit, we will be going on a bus tour of our city to see what it is like and how areas differ. We will compare our city of Stoke on Trent to a village.

Key words: village and city
