English

The children will be reading and writing about a story called *The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark* by Jill Tomlinson. We will be using questions in our writing as well as prefix un. We will carry on embedding punctuation and conjunctions. The children will also write a non-chronological report about owls.

Key words: prefix

Maths

The children will continue to learn addition and subtraction strategies. The children will continue with place value to 50 and learn about measures. In snappy maths, we will learning about 1 more and 1 less/ 2 more and 2 less. The children will still continue to work on recalling number pairs to 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10

Key words: measure

Science

The children will continue with the topic animals including humans. The learning will be about the structure of animals and about what animals eat. We will also revisit our seasonal change topic and explore what it is like in Spring.

Key words: herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.

Music

The children will be learning about combining pulse, rhythm and pitch.
