Phonics and Grammar Books – Pink

Phonics Folders – Blue

Expectations

- Anima worksheets to be dated and marked, stored in the individual phonics folders (marking – green ticks, pink for letter formation and where an error has been made)
- Anything within the phonics planning that says write on whiteboards (e.g. dictated sentences) must be written into the books and marked (picking up presentation, formation and errors).
- Presentation in books – to be modelled and expected every lesson
Date to be written in – short date and then begin task underneath
Following lesson – miss a line, short date and then begin task underneath
Grammar will also be written within these books following the same expectations of presentations (they will be in between the phonics/spelling tests – which is fine)
You may have 2 of the same dates but again that is fine as it indicates two lessons which will have different learning focus
- Books must be marked, worksheets don't need to be stuck in – it is more of a written practise/application style book
- Spelling tests will also be in these books, presentation to be modelled and then expected every time. Incorrect spellings to be pinked and written out correctly once
- Phonics – daily in books (unless it is a practical and worksheet apply)
- Grammar – recorded into books where appropriate. (These don't have to be extensive tasks e.g. could just be writing a list of adjectives or writing three expanded noun phrases etc)
