Spring 2 Curriculum Map

English

The children will be doing a non fiction unit about owls and will write a non-chronological report. Our text is *The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark* by Jill Tomlinson. The children will be learning about questions and the prefix 'un'. We will carry on embedding punctuation and conjunctions when retelling the story.

Key words: prefix

Maths

The children will continue to learn addition and subtraction strategies. Then we will learn about the place value of numbers up to 50. We will also cover measure, multiplication and division. In snappy maths, we will continue to work on 1 more and 1 less. We will still recap number facts to 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10

Key words: measure

Science

The children will continue with the topic animals including humans. The learning will be about the structure of animals and about what animals eat. We will also revisit our seasonal change topic and explore what it is like in Spring.

Music

The children will be learning about combining pulse, rhythm and pitch.
