English

The children will be reading and writing the traditional tale of Jack and the Beanstalk. We will continue to work on comprehension answering retrieval, vocabulary, inference and sequencing questions. We will be using questions in our writing as well as prefix un. We will continue to embed punctuation and conjunctions.

Key words: question

Maths

The children will learn the place value of numbers to 100. They will learn how to tell the time, about the value of coins and positional language. In snappy maths, we will be learning to use our number bonds to partition and adjust with concrete resources. We will continue to count in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Key words: o'clock and half past

Science

The children will be learning about plants. They will look at naming common plants and trees. The children will be going on a trip to Queen's Park. We will also revisit our seasonal change topic and explore what it is like in Summer and the difference in day length during the year.

The children will be learning about a range of musical styles. They will sing and compose using instruments.
