

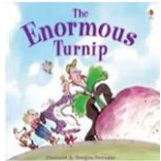


Reception

Autumn 1 Curriculum Map

English:

The children will be reading 'Owl Babies' by Martin Waddell, and 'The Enormous Turnip' by Katie Daynes.



They will learn to form letters correctly and write their full name.

Maths: Number

The children will be sorting, matching and comparing sets of objects. They will compare and measure weight and capacity. They will begin to create patterns. They will also deepen their understanding of 1,2,3.



KUW – Wanderlust:

The children will be learning to recognise what happens in Autumn and discuss the changes that they will see. We will investigate owls, apples, mushrooms and pumpkins. We will look carefully at the world around us.



Music:

We will be exploring and creating music with our voices.

Phonics:

The children will be learning to segment and blend for reading.

Enrichment:

- Owl Experience - we will meet owls and the animals they eat.
- We will visit Bearstone Fruit Farm to pick our own pumpkins.
- Make apple crumble.
- Make mushroom pizzas.
- We will look at our area on a map.

RE:

Being special - Where do we belong? Understanding the feeling of belonging.

KUW - People and Communities:

We will begin to understand our class and where we belong. We will talk about our families.



EAD – Art:

We will be learning how to mark make using different types of lines such as thick, thin, wavy and straight to create observational drawings and a self-portrait.
